- Prepare and share MTO / WSL / NDT rules in the Fabrication Management System and verify that the operation is successful and correct.
- For all changes generated in the yard to Design documentation, obtain preventive approval from Design Engineering.
- Predispose the issue of “As Built” design documentation, tracking all changes and relevant approval references in a Master Copy of Design documentation set, utilizing Red Marking where applicable.
- Issue “As Built” SHOP drawings/documentation.
- Contribute and support the project to pursue the best Engineering / Procurement / Installation solutions, accounting for Fabrication effectiveness (Constructability process).
- Interface with Project Design specialists to analyze and process Design deliverables of competence.
- Provide technical support to production activities, internal and subcontracted, and be the reference for any issue and support solutions involving Fabrication Design specialists when necessary.
- Keep technical documentation up to date, including Design documentation red mark-up with reference to approval documentation.
- Support drafting of the subcontractor’s scope of work.
- Any other duties as assigned by the supervisor
