In Guyana, Saipem is committed to implement along with its client the engineering, procurement, construction, and installation of offshore projects in the Stabroek Block with its distinctive competences and assets tailored to operate in harsh environments, remote and deep-water areas. Saipem has been awarded the SURF portions (subsea, umbilicals, risers & flowlines) of all the field development projects so far launched in Guyana, i.e.: Liza 1 & 2, Payara and Yellowtail.

Saipem Guyana is additionally committed to contribute to the development of the Guyanese people, to maximize the use local resources and to create even more capacity. Hence, we invite companies which fulfill with the Guyanese Local Content Law to submit an Expression of Interest (EOI) for the services/supplies in the area(s) listed herein.

The supply/service(s) would be performed in Guyana to support Saipem onshore operations.



Notes

1. All interested companies are informed that Saipem may enter into a contract at its sole discretion pursuant to this EOI and consequent competitive tender process, if any. In addition, the contracted company must be - at the time of the contract execution - a “Guyanese company” according to the Guyana Local Content Act No. 18 of 2021, Part I, 2, and be registered in the “Local Content Register” set up by the local Ministry of Natural Resources, all under the Guyana Local Content Act No. 18 of 2021, Part II, 6(1)(b) and Part II, 8.
2. Companies that DO NOT comply with the above requirements of the Guyana Local Content Act 2021 shall refrain from submitting their EOI.

Basic Requirements

- Registration in the *Local Content Register* and with the *Centre for Local Business Development (CLBD)*. Certificates proving these registrations must be provided along with the submission for this EOI.
- Submit the company profile inclusive of full contact details, physical address, Tax Identification No. (TIN), VAT number, details on any joint ventures, partnerships, etc., that are part of your organization’s structure.
- Submit the relevant experience and track-record (including clients and references) providing services/goods in the following categories:

Occupational Health and Infirmary Services

Specific Requirements:

1. Services shall be provided to perform Occupational Health Services aimed at monitoring Saipem Guyana Inc.’ employee’s health status based on specific health risks stemming from their worksite, professional roles and duties.
2. Vendors MUST be a licensed healthcare provider in compliance with all relevant local health and safety laws. Evidence of all relevant licenses must be provided.

Occupational Health Requirements:

3. Vendors MUST be able to perform offsite Drug and Alcohol testing, inclusive of drug screening, supply of pre-approved drug kits, alcohol screening and a qualified medical review officer to verify the integrity of all tests. Vendor must provide a list of equipment as well as evidence of having qualified technicians to perform the aforementioned tests.
4. Vendors MUST be able to provide Occupational Health Services. These Services include Medical Fitness Examinations, Laboratory Examinations, Occupational Health Diagnostic Procedures. Vendor MUST be qualified to issue relevant medical fitness certificates based on these tests. Vendor must provide a list of equipment as well as evidence of having qualified technicians to perform the aforementioned tests.
5. Vendors MUST also have access to a well outfitted certified medical care facility capable of executing this scope. A presentation showcasing this facility and its amenities will be necessary.



Infirmary Services Requirements:

6. Vendors shall also need to show capability to supply services to Saipem's Infirmery located at the Offshore Construction Facility at Lot A & B Water Street, Georgetown. These services MUST include provision of on-site Medical Personnel qualified in Primary Care, Response to Major Emergencies and infectious disease prevention and treatment. Vendors MUST submit copies of resumes of Doctors specialized in delivering emergency treatment.
7. Vendors should also be required to supply an on-call Ambulance Service. Evidence of relevant license to provide this must be presented.
8. Vendors MUST also be capable of providing all medical equipment, consumables and medicines necessary for the operation of an on-site Infirmery.
