

VACANCY: **GIE Electrical Technician**

Description: The GIE Electrical Technician is responsible for the electrical and technical maintenance duties at the Gafoors Industrial Estate (Annex)

Objectives:

Provide support to the Technical/Maintenance Department for all related duties.

Qualifications

Interested candidates are required to have:

- Minimum of three (3) years related-work experience in industrial electrical maintenance.
- Strong communication skills – written and verbal
- Good analytical and troubleshooting skills.
- Ability to learn quickly and consistently and work under pressure in a fast-paced environment
- Sound post-secondary education in electrical and electronic courses.
- Proficiency in the use of the National Electrical Code (NEC)
- Shall possess excellent electrical installation skills.
- Must have good attention to details
- Good working ethics and ability to treat documents with confidentiality
- Ability to work effectively within a team setting to achieve the objectives within timelines.
- Must be knowledgeable about site safety practices and be willing to adhere to GYSBI's safety requirements.

Duties

The successful candidate will perform duties such as:

- Conduct PM's (Daily, weekly, Monthly, Quarterly) for the Annex's facilities (Hydrosite, exhaust fans, roll-up doors, lighting, electrical installations etc.
- Daily inspections on electrical installations.
- Manage the water levels in the wastewater and processed water tanks, inclusive of forced evaporation (burning).
- Maintenance of burners.
- Conduct maintenance, installations, and any other pertinent activities at the GIE (annex) on behalf of GYSBI maintenance.
- Perform Quality Control post washing of pipes. Ensure that Operations clean-up and discard grease from the floor, drains and sump after the washing process.
