OBJECTIVE:

- Hold and manipulate the electrode holder, welding torch or carbon arc air gouge by hand
- To be qualified for Manual or semiautomatic, standard and non-standard processes (GTAW, SMAW, FCAW, GMAW) and carries out the welding work in compliance with safety, quality and in respect of environmental rules. The Welder will stay under the supervision of the (discipline) Welding Foreman
- Assist skilled workers in the performance of related discipline activities in accordance with safety and quality standards

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES:

- Carry out the Welding work in the planned times and costs
- Ensure the proper implementation of approved operating procedures
- Ensure observance of the WPSs and welding method statements
- Ensure that safety standards are respected
- Ensure that production quality and quantity standards are observed and issue the hand-over of completed works
- Carry out the welding qualification procedure and welder qualification tests when required
- Carry out the welding repairs or cosmetic weld toe adjustment in case of errors or defects by grinding or Carbon Arc Air gouge
- Participate to pipe/plate fit up with the pipe fitting and spacer team
- Clean welds after each pass, work areas, tools and equipment
- Perform a preliminary check of the welds after completion
- Ensure adequate handling and storage of welding consumables during production
- Maintain a good housekeeping of his working location reducing the environmental footprints
- Respect environments and environmental rules
- Perform basic work under skilled workers supervision following given instructions
- Assist skilled workers in the performance of works by positioning materials and holding materials or tools in position, manually transferring materials and equipment from one location to another, in a safe manner
- Participate to the Tool box Talks meeting, where required
- Report to the Welding Foreman and to the Supervisor assigned for specific tasks
