

**REQUEST FOR INFORMATION (RFI)**  
GUYANA DEEP WATER OPERATIONS INCORPORATED (GDO)

**Supply of Safety Signs**



## 1. BACKGROUND

**Guyana Deep Water Operations Incorporated (GDO)**, hereinafter referred to as the "Company", a subsidiary of SBM Offshore is the operator of the Liza Destiny, Liza Unity and Prosperity Floating Production, Storage and Offloading (FPSO) vessels. SBM Offshore provides floating production solutions to the offshore energy industry, over the full product life cycle, and is now in the EPCI phase of the Jaguar FPSO vessel for the Whiptail project. The Company is market-leading in leased floating production systems with multiple units currently in operation and has unrivalled operational experience in this field. The Company's main activities are the design, supply, installation, operation and life extension of FPSO vessels. These are either owned and operated by SBM Offshore and leased to its clients or supplied on a turnkey sale basis.

## 2. GUYANESE CONTENT

It is our commitment to long-term sustainability to create social and commercial benefits back to Guyana whenever possible without jeopardizing the HSSE & Quality of the products and services to be delivered as well as for our crew and facilities. Based on that, Guyanese companies – as per definition in Act No. 18 of 2021, LOCAL CONTENT ACT 2021 – are invited to answer the Request for Information (RFI) in order to potentially be qualified to provide the services herein described.

## 3. OBJECTIVES

This RFI seeks technical and operational information from suppliers to meet the Company's bid selection requirements for the **Supply of Safety Signs**.

This RFI has several objectives:

- We may use responses from you and the other participants to validate and further develop the Company's recommendations for the Request for Quotation (RFQ). The RFI process allows us to seek your input and develop a list of qualified bidders before structured bid rules take effect.
- Second, the RFI process provides you with an opportunity to begin developing your responses to some of the potential requirements if you are selected for the RFQ.
- Third, the RFI process may also present the opportunity to initiate the vendor qualification process in relation to the scope of work for future supply.

Finally, depending on responses from you and the other participants, the Company may unbundle the services described in this RFI and in a future RFQ into several enabling agreements that may be awarded to more than one bidder.

## 4. SCOPE OF SUPPLY

### a. Description

The Company is looking for Guyanese company(ies) to produce safety signs (including fixings & fittings such as boards, pipe clamps, etc.) for installation on the FPSO.

In total 515 (including 150 pieces of backing board) safety signs are expected to be supplied in accordance with the specified requirements. Additionally, the scope of supply shall include 300 pieces of clamps for the backing board.

### b. Scope of Supply Requirement(s)

- The quantity of the required safety signs shall be as per attachment 1
- Graphics for the safety signs and size requirements shall be as per attachment 2
- Applicable international standards as described below:
  - IMO A.752 (18) Low Location Lighting
  - IMO A.1116(30) Graphic Symbols for shipboard fire control plans
  - IMO A.1023(23) Code on Alerts and Indicators, 2009
  - IMDG Code. International Maritime Dangerous Goods Code (resolution MSC.122(75), as amended)
  - 2009 MODU Code. Code for the Construction and Equipment of Mobile Offshore Drilling Units, 2009 (resolution A.1023(26))
  - Resolution A.481(XII). Principles of safe manning
  - Fire Safety Systems (FSS) code, 2015 Ed., up to amendments in Resolutions MSC.403(96) and MSC.410(97)
  - Life-Saving Appliances (LSA) Code, consolidated edition, up to amendments in MSC.425(98)
  - SOLAS International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS), 2020
  - ISO3864 1,2,3,4 Graphical symbols — safety colors and safety signs
  - ISO7010 Graphical symbols — safety colors and safety signs — registered safety signs
  - ISO-15370 Low Location Lighting (IMO special purpose code)
  - ISO17398 Classification, performance and durability of safety signs
  - ISO-23601 Safety identification — escape plan signs
  - ISO24409 1,2,3 Ships and marine tech. — Design, location and use of shipboard safety signs

- Design life – minimum 7 years
- All safety signs shall be in English

- The bidder shall sign and return the NON-DISCLOSURE AGREEMENT document provided.
- The bidder shall provide the SCOPE OF SUPPLY REQUIREMENTS' documents, under item 4, if mentioned.
- The bidder shall provide additional information using prescribed forms or templates when specifically instructed.

## 7. DELIVERY

- a. All documents required shall be delivered to the following email addresses before the RFI due date, February 21, 2025 COB (Close of Business, 17:00hrs). No delay or extension will be granted.
