## Scope of Work

MODEC Guyana Inc. requests the services of a SUB-CONTRACTOR to provide Commissioning Technicians Supply for our Company, including Senior and Junior roles in Mechanical, Electrical, Instrumentation & Control, and Telecom disciplines.

The Vendor must propose and hire suitable candidates, ensure Compliance with Safety and Site Regulations, provide necessary tools and PPE, secure insurance coverage, and administer timely compensation.

Technicians should have relevant degrees or diplomas, a minimum of 3 years of experience, and strong technical, troubleshooting, and communication skills. The supplier must also handle logistics, documentation, and performance monitoring, ensuring adherence to Health, Safety, Security, and Environment (HSSE) requirements.

## Requirements

Requirements of the Technicians:

- a) Relevant technical qualifications: Degree/Diploma in relevant engineering fields or any trade certificates.
- b) Experience: Minimum 3 years of experience in the related field or relevant commissioning experience in more than 3 FPSO/FSO projects.
- c) Valid certifications for Offshore work (e.g., BOSIET, HUET, STCW).
- d) Specialized certifications as required for specific roles (e.g., NDT, CompEx, HV operations, rigging & lifting).
- e) Should be able to communicate in English written & spoken.
- f) Skills: Good communication, leadership, and interpersonal skills. Strong technical, problem-solving and troubleshooting skills.
- g) Able to work independently as well as in a team.
- h) Ability to work under pressure and in challenging offshore conditions.
- i) Familiarity with hazardous areas, ATEX requirements, and use of relevant tools and test equipment.
- j) Familiar with drawings and procedures of various disciplines such as loop drawings, electrical drawings, P&ID, block diagram, layout drawings, C&E, logic diagrams, etc.
- k) Good documentation skills, including red-line/as-built drawing markup preparation.
- l) Commitment & understanding of safety and adherence to HSE standards.
- m) Familiarity with Permit-To-Work (PTW) system and Lock-Out Tag-Out (LOTO) procedures.
- n) Technical Knowledge:
  - Knowledge of mechanical, electrical, instrumentation, and telecom systems.
  - Ability to handle hydraulic units, N2-He leak testing, and commissioning of various equipment.
