**OBJECTIVE:**

Drive the assigned vehicle following Foreman (or other reference people in the plant, base, yard, field facilities) instructions, in accordance with safety and quality standards and following field/ local road and traffic laws/ regulations.

**RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES:**

- Follow daily instructions given by Foreman in accordance with safety standards and applicable field/ local roads and traffic laws/ regulations
- Ensure on time arrival at the pick up and drop off point respecting speed limits
- Report immediately to proper authority whenever a vehicle is involved in an accident regardless of the extent of damage
- Verify the vehicle is clean and in good operating conditions and report any anomalies to Foreman
- Verify the vehicle daily checklist in order to be ready for correct operations. Perform pre pre-trip, en-route and post-trip inspection of vehicle.
- Ensure the maximum attention is paid in order not to cause any harm or damage with the use of the vehicle
- Follow the permit-to-work statement and obtain necessary documents to transport goods
- Ensured cargo is secured properly and compliant with safety and quality requirements
- Follow the load and unload cargo
- Keep a log of activities (i.e. cargo information, hours of service, distance travelled, fuel expenditure, etc.)
