- To be qualified for Manual or semiautomatic process (Gtaw, Smaw, Fcaw, Gmaw) and carry out the welding work in compliance with safety, quality and in respect of environmental rules. The Structural/pipe welder will stay under the supervision of the (discipline) Welding Foreman.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES:

- Carry out the Welding work in the planned times and costs.
- Ensure the proper implementation of approved operating procedures.
- Ensure observance of the WPSs and welding method statements
- Ensure that safety standards are respected.
- Ensure that production quality and quantity standards are observed and issue the hand-over of completed works.
- Carry out the welding qualification procedure and welder qualification tests when required.
- Carry out the welders' repairs or cosmetic weld to adjust in case of errors or defects.
- Participate in pipe/plate fit-up with the pipe fitting and spacer team.
- Clean welds after each pass.
- Perform a preliminary check of the welds after completion.
- Maintain good housekeeping of his working place reducing the environmental footprints.
- Respect environments and environmental rules.
- Ensure adequate handling and storage of welding consumables.
- Any other duties as assigned.
