## Request for Expressions of Interest

### Environmental, Regulatory, and Socioeconomic Support for Proposed EEPGL Development Project Activities

Our focus on industry-leading companies places ERM at the forefront of new and developing industries. In keeping with that focus, ERM has a registered office in Guyana and is seeking expressions of interest (EOI) from qualified companies and individuals based in Guyana to assist ERM in providing environmental, regulatory, and socioeconomic support to Esso Exploration and Production Guyana Limited's (EEPGL's) future proposed development project activities. The nature of the required support could include some or all of the following services, among others:

- Completion of environmental and socioeconomic field data collection, potentially including the following types of studies:
  - Sea turtle tagging and telemetry tracking
  - Coastal bird surveys
  - Offshore marine bird surveys
  - Participatory fishing surveys (constituting interactions with local fisherfolk to gather information on their activities)
  - Nearshore and offshore marine fish surveys
  - Surveys of marine vessel movements along the coast and in Georgetown Harbour
  - Onshore air quality monitoring
  - Offshore air quality monitoring
  - Marine mammal surveys along the coast and in Georgetown Harbour
  - Vehicular traffic studies
  - Surveys of housing and lodging supply and demand in the Georgetown area
- Completion of environmental modeling (air quality dispersion modeling, water quality modeling, spill modeling, noise modeling, etc.)
- Preparation of Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) documentation
- Planning for and completion of stakeholder engagement activities related to the Environmental Authorisation process, including interactions with regulatory agencies, sectoral agencies, non-governmental organizations, and community members, among others.

Individuals who wish to be considered for these types of services should demonstrate the following minimum qualifications in their responses to this Request for EOI:

- A statement of specific areas the individual has interest and capability in supporting
- A bachelor's degree in one of the physical, social, or life science or engineering disciplines\*





- One to three years of professional experience in a field related to their degree

\*in cases where a candidate does not possess the required degree but can demonstrate particularly strong and relevant professional experience, ERM may consider such experience in lieu of the required educational credentials. Such highly qualified candidates are encouraged to apply, but exceptions to the aforementioned educational qualifications will only be considered for particularly strong and experienced candidates.

Individuals responding to the Request for EOI should demonstrate in their responses a proven record of providing one or more of the services listed above, preferably in Guyana. Demonstrated success in supporting regulatory approvals for extractive industry activities in Guyana is also highly desirable.

In addition to demonstrating the minimum requirements stated above for individuals, in order to be considered for this opportunity Guyana-based companies responding to this Request for EOI should include the following information in their responses:

- A summary of the company's management structure
- Professional profiles/curricula vitae of key Guyana-based employees (to include senior management and any specialists who would be nominated to work with ERM in a technical capacity)
- Physical address
- Available resources (e.g., offices and/or meeting spaces, laboratories, storage facilities, wharf or port facilities, warehouses, vessels, etc.)

The purpose of this Request for EOI is to seek opportunities for ERM to optimize the use of local Guyanese service providers in the provision of its support to EEPGL; accordingly, only companies or individuals based in Guyana will be considered. Responding companies should also indicate whether they are currently: 1) registered with the Guyana Revenue Authority as a business entity in Guyana; and 2) registered with the Centre for Local Business Development (CLBD). Neither of these registrations are pre-requisites for consideration under this Request for EOI, so lack of either registration would not necessarily eliminate a company from consideration.

Although not required, interested companies and individuals are also encouraged to include additional details that may assist ERM in evaluating responses. Such information could include but would not necessarily be limited to relevant professional training, certificates, licences, or prior coursework.
