Description: We are currently seeking an experienced Fuel Bunkering Supervisor to oversee the safe and efficient operation of the fuel plant and the supporting equipment and systems.

Job Type: Long Term Role with 12-hours shift schedule

Qualifications

Interested candidates are required to have:

- Five (5) years' experiences in a related position and environment with knowledge of the methods, techniques, and practices of water/wastewater treatment
- Knowledge of PPE and basic safety precautions
- Basic knowledge of MS Office
- Technical capacity
- Able to organize, plan and execute work effectively, independently and within teams
- Able to work well under pressure and meet deadlines
- Self-starter (willing to take initiative rather than waiting to be told what to do)

Duties

The successful candidate will perform duties such as:

- Plan physical fuel deliveries in coordination with operational guidelines and schedules
- Coordinate with fuel supplier to maintain appropriate levels of fuel and ensure the quality of service & fuel
- Coordinate with selected vessels / MOT before arrival in port to ensure readiness for fuel discharge thus minimizing any delays
- Monitor fuel discharge setup both on the vessel and the barge to ensure the operation will be safe, smooth, swift, and pollution-free
- Ensuring regular inspection is carried out on all equipment and monitor operating conditions, gauges, and meters
- Ensure regular maintenance, calibration, and maintain sensitive electronic data collection devices necessary for the fuel plant
- Ensure that regulations are adhered to and ensure safety standards are met
- Adhere to written operating procedures for shutdown and start-up of equipment
- Keep written records and generate reports as required by management

- Participate in bunker saving initiatives in close coordination with relevant stakeholders
- Other duties as assigned
