- Ensure adequate HSE reporting in line with Company procedures.
- Inspect subcontractors' activities.
- Control compliance with the equipment utilised on-site.
- Monitor the effective implementation of the Permit to Work system on site.
- Prepare and administer HSE Key Performance Indicators for the operational activities.
- Assist in the investigation of accidents and analysis to identify trends and propose the necessary corrective measures.
- Monitor and maintain control measures in the use of hazardous materials.
