



Navigational Watch Rating

Objective:

- Steer the vessel, keep proper look out by sight and hearing, contribute to monitoring and controlling a safe watch, operate emergency equipment.
- Act on request on deck marine rigging activity.

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Report to Able Seafarer Deck
- Carry out watch on keeping duties and marine activities in a safe manner

Experience and Skills:

- Capability to perform general maintenance, repair of the vessel such scraping, cleaning priming and painting.
- Knowledge of the main risks during the operation activities and safe working and environmental protection procedures/practices and rules to be applied.
- Knowledge of adequate Personal Protective Equipment – purpose, use and maintenance.
- Knowledge and the correct use of Permit to Work system.
- Capability to maintain watch stander duty including lookout and standing watch as helmsman and execute orders properly.
- Knowledge of mooring and unmooring and anchor operations and the risks involved.

- High School graduate
- In possession of relevant trade certificate (NWR/Subsea)
- STCW required Certificates, NATIONAL CoP Reg 11/4
- Fluent both in spoken and written English
