Accommodation vessel services

Scope of Work

Appropriate Accommodation vessel services for minimum 150 POB required for August 2026 and shall be available until and in operation until March, 2027.

- 1) AV must be available for the period: August 2026 – March 2027 with possible option(s) to extend.
- 2) Minimum capacity of 150 beds.
- 3) DP-2 or DP-3 system suitable for safe connectivity, management, and transit between the FPSO (freeboard of approximately 20 metres) and AV offshore.
- 4) Marine crew for DP operations (and gangway personnel) provided on 24/7 work basis.
- 5) High uptime relevant to the period and location.
- 6) Personnel On Board (POB) management system.
- 7) Compatible with the FPSO to have a suitable safe connectivity (either 24/7 or as and when required for the personnel on board transit between FPSO and AV).
- 8) Helideck suitable to receive Sikorsky S-92 type of helicopter, and at exceptional cases, -Augusta Westland (AW)-139 (min load of 12.6 tons, diameter of 20.9m - Helideck to be inspected and helideck crew certified for transfer management).
- 9) Cater for the personnel accommodation rooms/bed with an option for single, shared et cetera and provide daily quality catering, cleaning, laundry, as a routine day to day activity (on a 24 hours basis).
- 10) Food supply and provision of containers (including refrigerated containers). Provide/arrange supply run from shore as necessary.
- 11) Provide waste management: supply of waste skips with capacity to load/offload from supply vessels.
- 12) Fuel supply and refueling at offshore site.
- 13) Compliance with Modec Guyana Inc, ExxonMobil Guyana Limited and all local requirements.
