Notes:

1) All interested companies are informed that Saipem may - at its sole discretion - enter into a contract with a company pursuant to this “Expression of Interest” and consequent competitive tender process. Also, the contracted company must be at the time of the contract execution a “Guyanese company” according to the Guyana Local Content Act No. 18 of 2021, Part I, 2, and be registered in the “Local Content Register” of Guyanese companies set up by the local Guyanese competent authorities, all under the Guyana Local Content Act No. 18 of 2021, Part II, 6(1)(b) and Part II, 8.

2) Companies that do NOT comply with all related requirements of the local content act above from the Government of the Republic of Guyana shall refrain from submitting their expression of interest (EOI).

EOI Requirements

- Registration with the Local Content Secretariat and Centre for Local Business Development (CLBD)
- Proof of CLBD Registration must be supplied with your submission –copy of confirmation email or image/snapshot of supplier’s profile.
- Local Content Certificate must be supplied or evidence showing that the registration process has been started.
- Submit a company profile inclusive of full contact details, physical address, Tax Identification No. (TIN), VAT, details on any joint ventures, partnerships, etc. that are part of your organization’s structure.
- Submit with the EOI presentation the relevant experience and track record in the oil and gas sector (including clients and references) providing services/goods in the following categories:

Cargo Barge(s)

Characteristics:

- Length: 250 - 300 feet
- Breath: 80 - 100 feet
- Max. draft loaded: 6.0 meters
- Minimum Deck strength: 10 - 15 T/sqm
- Age: Max 15-20 years old

Equipment required:

- Certified Main & Emergency Towing Gear, inclusive of pickup line and buoy for the Emergency Towing Gear
- Messenger line attached to the main towing line
- Main Towing Arrangement: 2-off towing Smit Brackets
- Towing gear recovery winch (electric or manual) – Winch must be able to recover the towing gear to prevent the towing gear from dragging on the seabed in the port.
- Fenders, minimum fender for approaching alongside the Jetty
- Double Bollards and two spare bollards
- Mooring lines: 4-off certified mooring lines (in good condition) and 4-off spare mooring lines for securing the cargo barge
- Access ladders: Rigid and permanent access ladders on STBD and PORT sides.
- Portable ballast pumps if no internal ballast system available

Classification:

- The cargo barge shall be ballastable and classified by a member of the International Association of Classification Societies.
